#### **METHODOLOGY**



2,273 Ontarians were surveyed between January 21<sup>st</sup> and January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022.



We used the *Lucid Exchange Platform* as the sample provider, which blends a variety of partner panels.



If the survey was a probability-based random sample of the same size, it would be considered accurate to +/- 2.1 nineteen times out of twenty.









#### Results are sub-regionally weighted for:


- Age, Education and birth sex according to the 2016 Census.
- 2018 Ontario Election Vote.

#### ONTARIO DECIDED + LEANING

Ford's Ontario PCs lead by four points province wide.

Horwath's NDP have lost three points since the 2018 election.

Del Duca's Liberals have gained four points since the 2019 election.






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## GREATER TORONTO AREA DECIDED + LEANING

Ford's PCs lead in three of five GTA regions.

Opposition evenly divided in two of the five regions of the GTA.

In Central Toronto, the NDP lead the Liberals and PCs.





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


#### REST OF ONTARIO DECIDED + LEANING

Outside of Toronto, NDP show considerable strength in Midwestern Ontario.

Eastern Ontario sees opposition parties evenly splitting the non-PC vote.

NDP and PCs are tied in both Southwestern Ontario and Northern Ontario.





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


# AGE AND BIRTH SEX DECIDED + LEANING

PCs skew older and male.

Liberals are consistent among males, skew older among females.

NDP skew female and younger.






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# VISIBLE MINORITY / UNION STATUS DECIDED + LEANING

Little difference between visible minorities and nonvisible minorities.

NDP favoured among public-sector union workers,

PCs favoured among private-sector and non-unionized people.






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


# PARENTS AND NON-PARENTS DECIDED + LEANING

PCs popular among males without children living at home.

NDP more popular among females without children living at home.







#### GROWING THE PARTIES

Every Party has three groups they need to consider. **Core** - Voters who intend to vote for their party and voted for them in the previous election.

**Soft** - Voters who intend to vote for their party but voted for a different party in the previous election.


**Swing** - Voters who do not intend to vote for the party currently but show an openness to switching their vote to that party.

- Swing Voters are the most politically coveted for any party, as they are the most likely to switch and grow the party.

#### GREATER TORONTO AREA

Ford's PCs have room to grow in Peel Region.

They have already made significant gains in both Peel Region and Suburban Toronto






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### REST OF ONTARIO

They have already made gains in Northern Ontario.







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### AGE AND BIRTH SEX

They also have room to grow among women.








#### VISIBLE MINORITY / UNION STATUS

Visible Minorities and unionized Ontarians are a source of potential growth for Ford's PCs.









### PARENTS AND NON-PARENTS

being swing voters.









#### GREATER TORONTO AREA

For Horwath's NDP, growth opportunities in the GTA are consistent across the region.









### REST OF ONTARIO

grown considerably.








### AGE AND BIRTH SEX

They have significant opportunity to grow among all age and birth sex groups.








#### VISIBLE MINORITY / UNION STATUS

They have potential to grow among private sector union members and visible minorities.






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### PARENTS AND NON-PARENTS

For Horwath's NDP, 24% of mothers are swing voters.









#### GREATER TORONTO AREA

For Del Duca's Liberals, Toronto represents their biggest opportunity to grow, geographically.








### REST OF ONTARIO

Northern Ontario.






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### AGE AND BIRTH SEX

Young Ontarians represent a considerable opportunity for growth for Del Duca's Liberals with 26% of young males and 28% of young females being Ontario Liberal swing voters.








#### VISIBLE MINORITY / UNION STATUS
