

METHODOLGY



1,232 Alberta residents were surveyed between May 25 – May 26, 2023.

We used the *Lucid Exchange Platform* as the sample provider, which blends a variety of partner panels.


If the survey was a probability-based random sample of the same size, it would be considered accurate to +/- 3% nineteen times out of twenty.

The survey was self-commissioned and paid for by Counsel Public Affairs.

Results are weighted for:

• Age, gender, region, and education according to the most recent Census.






Topline Findings

- Decided and leaning voters slightly favour the NDP (46%) over the UCP (41%) and other parties are currently at (14%).
- The NDP lead the advance polls with 43% to the UCP 35%.
- Undecided voters are leaning toward the UCP with 24%, and the NDP is not far behind with 20%.
- 10% of respondents already voted in the advance polls.






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Q: In the PROVINCIAL election on Monday, May 29, which party will you vote for?




VOTING INTENTION: ALREADY VOTED IN ADVANCE POLLS

Q: Please tell us which party you voted for:






Q: In the PROVINCIAL election on Monday, May 29, which party will you vote for?






DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN

Topline Findings


- The NDP is leading Edmonton with 37% and UCP at 22%.
- In Calgary, the NDP (33%) has a slight lead to the UCP (28%).
- Notley's NDP is winning over female voters of all ages, 33% (18-34), 31% (35-54), and 36% (55+).
- Men (35 54) in Edmonton are tied, between UCP (35%) and NDP (35%).
- The UPC continues to lead amongst male voters 55+ (42%) and all voters 65+ (40%) and with voters outside of Calgary and Edmonton at 33%.






VOTING INTENTION: CALGARY – DECIDED VOTERS






VOTING INTENTION: EDMONTON – DECIDED VOTERS





VOTING INTENTION: REST OF ALBERTA – DECIDED VOTERS


























VOTING INTENTION: CALGARY – DECIDED + LEANING VOTERS












