505

505 Manitoba residents 18+ were surveyed between September 11 – September 16, 2023.

The survey were conducted online by way of the *Leger Opinion (LEO) Panel*.

Margin of error is not applicable for online surveys, however, if the surveys were probability-based random samples of the same size, it would be considered accurate to $\pm 4\%$ nineteen times out of twenty.

Results are weighted for:

- Age, gender, and region according to the most recent Census.



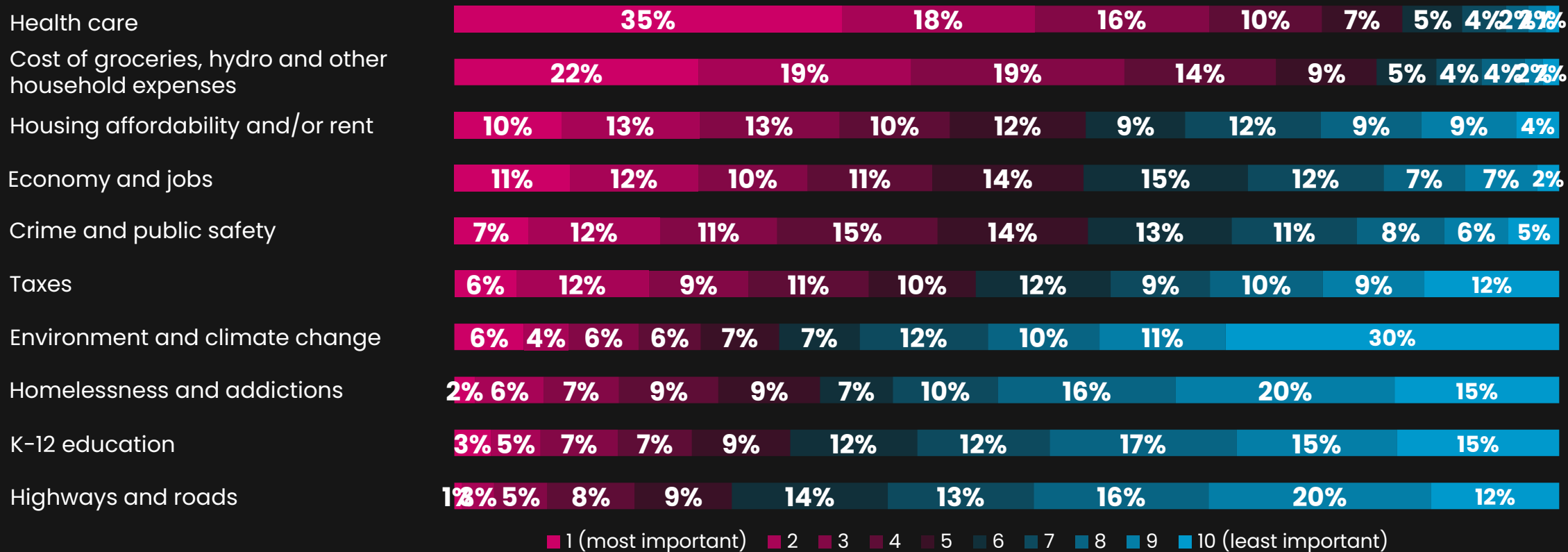

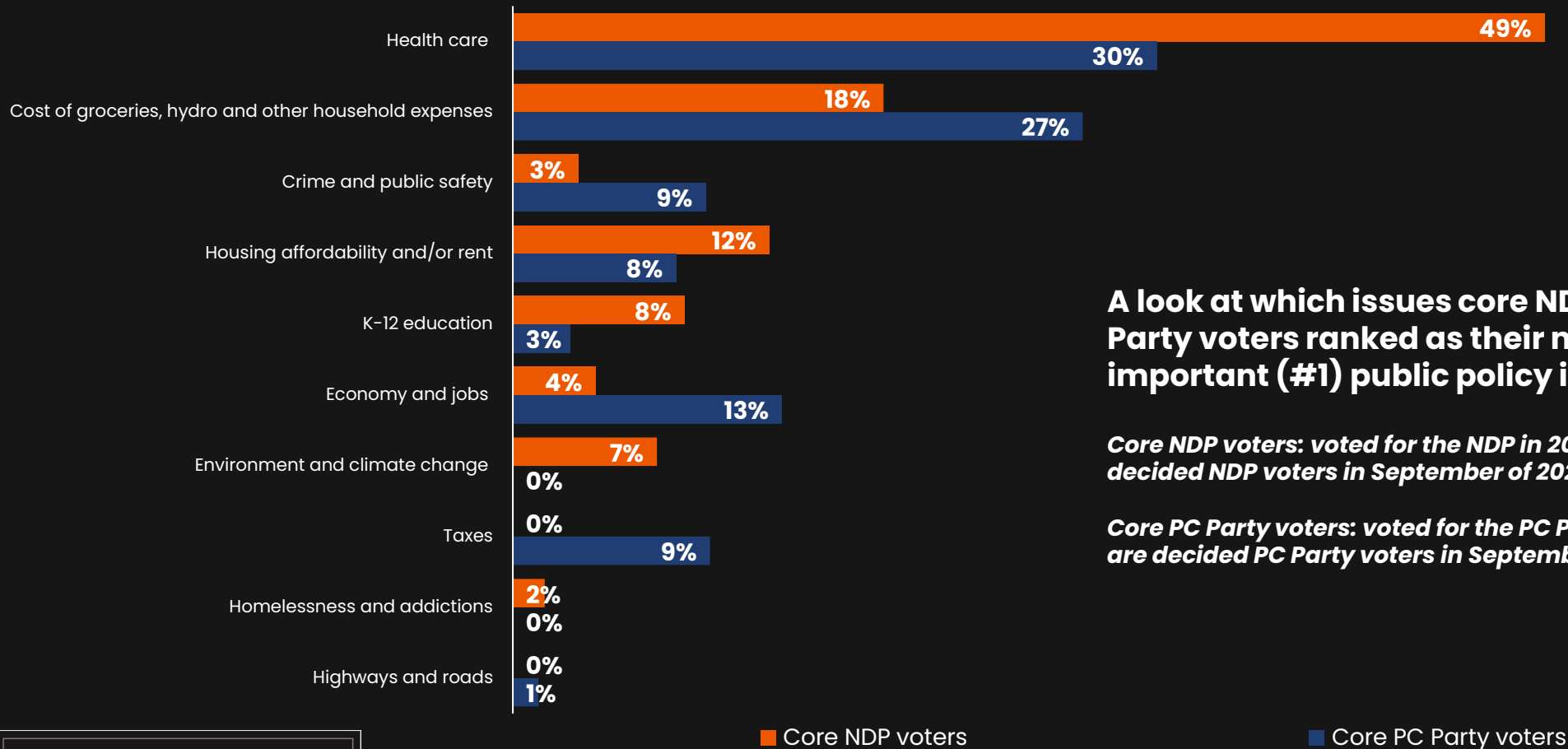
POLICY PRIORITIES – MANITOBBANS OVERALL

Q: Please tell us how important each of the following public policy issues are to you from first, meaning most important, to last, meaning least important.



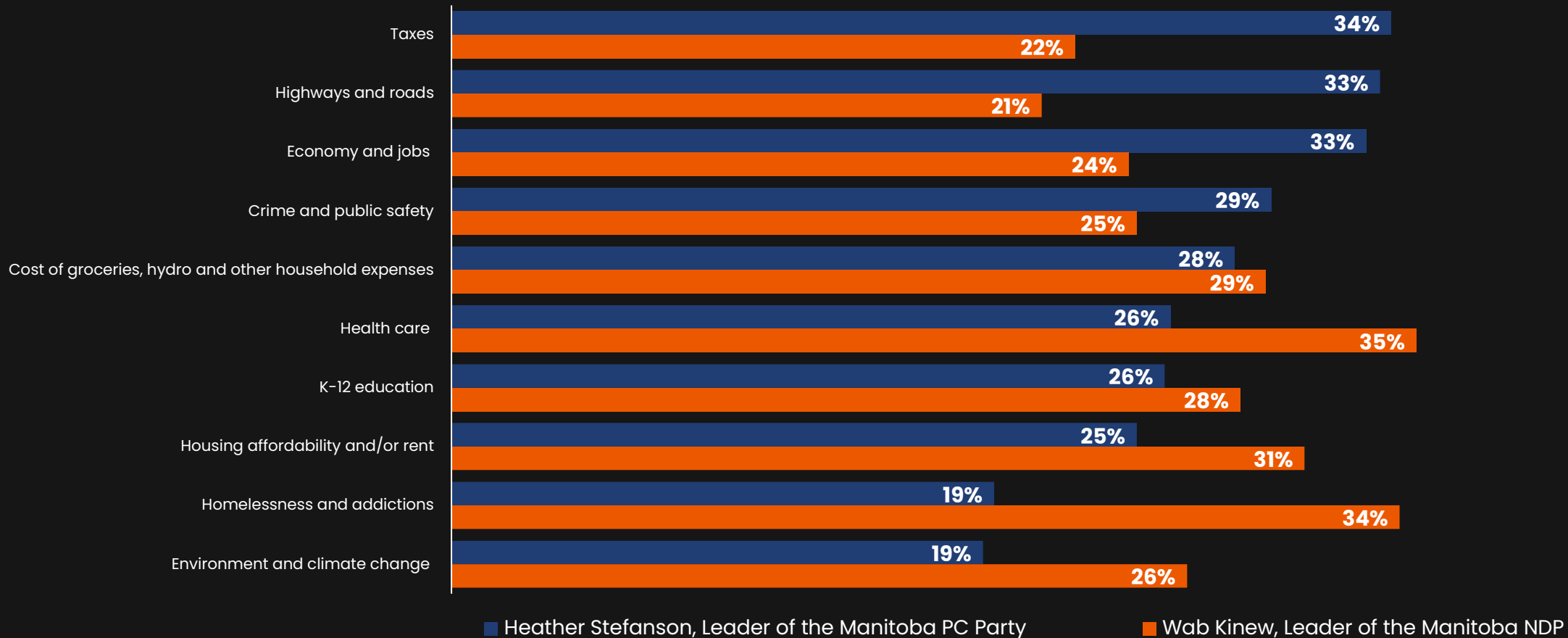
A look at which issues core NDP and PC Party voters ranked as their number most important (#1) public policy issue.
