Methodology

505 Manitoba residents were surveyed between September 11 – September 16, 2023.

The survey was conducted online by way of the Leger Opinion (LEO) Panel.

If the survey was a probability-based random sample of the same size, it would be considered accurate to +/- 4% nineteen times out of twenty. Results are weighted for:

Age, gender, and region according to the most recent Census. The survey was self-commissioned and paid for by Counsel Public Affairs.
